### **CARB Verifies Cleaire Allmetal™**

Cleaire Receives CARB Level 3+ Verification

SAN LEANDRO, Calif., December 28, 2009 – Officials of Cleaire Advanced Emission Controls, LLC announced today that the California Air Resources Board (CARB) has verified the Allmetal diesel emission retrofit system as Level 3+ for off-road applications, reducing tailpipe diesel particulate matter (PM) by greater than 85%. The Level 3+ designation makes the Allmetal eligible for government financial incentive programs and can be used to meet regulatory requirements such as CARB Fleet Rules and New York Local Laws.

This CARB determination, effective December 22, 2009, allows the Allmetal to be installed on 1996 through 2010 model year non-EGR engines from 6.7 to 18.2 liters displacement (150-600 horsepower). The Allmetal is based on a sintered metal filter (catalyzed) with passive regeneration, ideal for demanding off-road applications, including tracked machines, like wheel loaders, dozers, road graders and excavators.
